- Contact Information for RFP Submitter (if different that webinar moderator)
- Proposed Webinar Speakers

Once approved, APPAM will be responsible for the following:

- Webinar Technology All Webinars are hosted on GoToWebinar.
- Webinar Promotion and Registration Webinars will be featured prominently on APPAM's website, social media accounts, and monthly member newsletters.
- Webinar Registration APPAM manage, monitor, and track registration for the webinar.
- Posting the Webinar on APPAM.org upon completion.
- Monitoring the Webinar Q&A (if applicable)

Webinar proposals will be received on a rolling basis. Once received, the proposal will be reviewed by APPAM staff and the APPAM Professional Development Committee.
